His work at CSIC has been focused on the role and applications of microbial diversity using a wide variety of methodologies, among others microbiology, ecology, physiology, biochemistry, and genomics. The study of microorganisms and their communities is being performed in a variety of environments and systems often using extremophilic conditions as models. One of the topics of his work includes the treatment of residues and pollutants.
