EXPERTISE: Dr. Francisco Raposo has been working in the AD research field since 1998, when he started his scientific career as a fellowship student. He obtained his PhD in 2002, after four years carrying out research study on the AD of olive mill wastewater. Later, Dr. Raposo worked for 16 months as postdoctoral visiting researcher at the University of Southampton (UK). In 2008 he obtained a permanent position as tenured scientist at the Instituto de la Grasa, a research centre which belongs to CSIC (Spanish Council for Scientific Research). Recently, he has started the coordination of the ADRIL (the acronym derives from the names “Anaerobic Digestion Research-ADR” and “Interlaboratory-IL”) project, which has as a mission to contribute to an effective knowledge for the AD field by providing support to laboratories to obtain data which are “fit for purpose” and thus comparable with those of other laboratories in the same field.
